

Completion Requirements

The following are requirements of Baca County 4-H and MUST be completed:

1. Enroll in at least one 4-H project. The maximum number of projects that any one member can be enrolled in are as follows:
 - For returning members with zero projects completed the previous year, a maximum of one project can be taken.
 - For returning members with a portion of projects completed the previous year, a maximum of one less than the projects completed the previous year can be taken.
 - For returning members that completed all projects the previous year, there is no maximum number of projects. (no more than 5 is suggested)
 - For first year members there is no maximum number of projects that can be taken. (no more than 2 is recommended)
2. Give at least one 4-H project related demonstration, illustrated talk, or presentation at a club meeting.
 - Other presentation locations may be approved by your Club Leader and Extension Agent if appropriate.
3. Participate in at least one 4-H sponsored community service activity.
4. Livestock and Horse project member's record books must be up-to-date and checked by the Extension Staff at/or no later than the cleanup day prior to the Baca County Fair.
5. Complete any club level requirements as stated in the chartered club's bylaws.
6. Items 1-5 must be completed no later than the cleanup day prior to the Baca County Fair in order to exhibit at the Baca County Fair.
7. Exhibit project (livestock or non-livestock) at the Baca County Fair. This includes completing an interview for non-livestock projects at Exhibit Day.
 - **Any exceptions due to extenuating circumstances must be discussed with and approved by the Extension Agent prior to the Baca County Fair.**
 - Giving an additional demonstration in place of exhibiting at the Baca County Fair will not be accepted.
8. Attend a minimum of one fair cleanup day.
 - Club Leaders will assign which cleanup day you are to attend.
 - Any exceptions due to extenuating circumstances must be approved by Club Leader and the Extension Agent at least 48 hours prior to assigned cleanup day.
9. Must worked assigned shift in the Baca County 4-H Concession Stand.
 - Club Leaders will assign shifts prior to the Baca County Fair.
10. Complete appropriate record book for each enrolled project by the appropriate deadlines.
11. You must complete at least one 4-H project to receive a year end completion certificate.
