

Baca County 4-H Council Scholarship

Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior who is a current 4-H member in Baca County, actively participating in the Baca County 4-H Council, and completed a minimum of one year as a Baca County 4-H Council delegate or officer.
2. Applicant must plan to attend a vocational, junior, community college, or university within the United States as a full-time undergraduate.
3. Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.0 or above.
4. Application must be received by April 1 at 4:30 p.m.
5. Application must be complete for consideration.

Recipient will be chosen based on 4-H involvement, leadership, scholarship and community involvement.

1. Applicants must submit the following:
 - a. Application form.
 - b. Resume highlighting their leadership, scholarship and community involvement. Resume should **emphasize** 4-H, but include experiences from other organizations. See the website: http://www.ehow.com/how_5329262_write-high-school-scholarship-resume.html for information on resumes, or visit your school counselor. Please limit resume to two pages.
 - c. Responses to two short essay questions for a total of 500 words (250 words each). 1. What are your future plans? 2. How has 4-H made an impact on your life?
 - d. High school transcript(s).
 - e. Two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from a 4-H leader or Extension Agent. The other letter may be from a non-related reference of your choice.
 - f. Photo of applicant. Photo should be no larger than 3"X5".
